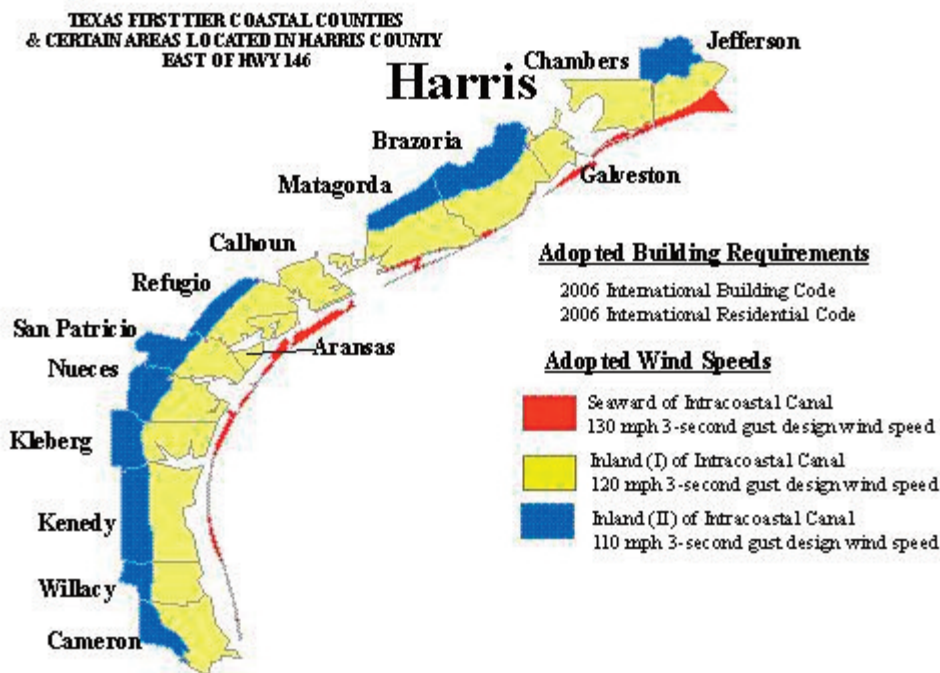
Ceco Door is pleased to announce a new Texas Department of Insurance evaluation report, DR-490 (Along with DR-294 and DR-295).

The TDI polystyrene door and frame is impact resistant and has a design pressure of +/-80 psf. The door and frame can be installed in facilities located along the Texas Gulf Coast in the Designated Hurricane Catastrophe areas.

The approved latching hardware, which includes mortise locks and rim exits, may be used by architects and contractors for many exterior openings. The door and frame are built to SDI and HMMA requirements in order to meet architectural specifications.
